According to the company, the paint is engineered to be hand applied with a sponge to impart natural granite veins in the countertop.

They claim the process is designed for the Do-It-Yourselfer and takes the beginning painter about four hours to apply, and sixteen hours to dry – so it's a weekend project.

The granite paint comes in two colors – “Sicilian Sand” and “Bombay Black” and retails in stores or online for about \$48.90. It's backed with a 100% satisfaction guarantee.
